

Lesson Plan – Objects Comparative

<u>Level</u>: Elementary <u>Length</u>: 90 minutes <u>Topic</u>: Common Objects

Objectives: Review of lexis (objects / adjectives)

Language: Comparatives and Superlatives

Function: talking about things in relation to each other

Activity	Description	Time
Warmer:	Taboo: Divide class into two teams. One person from each	15 min
Review Lexis	team is shown a flashcard. They must describe, act out, or	
	draw the word. The first team to guess the word gets a	
	point.

	Two students come to the front of the class. A word is	
	written on the board, behind them. Their teammates	
	describe the word to them. The first player to say the word	
	gets a point for his / her team.	
Present	Show two object flashcards. Elicit which one is bigger.	8 min
Language:	Present the target language:	
Comparative	The computer is bigger than the MP3 player.	
	Drill pronunciation.	
	Repeat the process with beautiful.	
	The purse is more beautiful than the bike.	
Matching	Draw a table on the board with '+ er than' and "more	5 min
	than" as the headings	
	Give the students adjective cards, and they place them in the	
	proper column.	
	Feedback to the class / Students copy down the chart.	
Controlled	Students look at the pictures on their possessions	7 min
Practice	worksheet. They work in pairs saying sentences comparing	
	two objects at a time.	

	Feedback to the class	
Present	Put three or four object flashcards on the board. Elicit which	8 min
Language:	is the cheapest.	
Superlative	Present the target language:	
	The wallet is the cheapest (thing).	
	Drill Pronunciation	
	Repeat the process with expensive:	
	The computer is the most expensive (thing).	
Matching	Add headings to the comparative table: 'the+ est' and	5 min
	'the most'	
	Students place adjective cards in the proper column.	
	Feedback to the class / Students copy down the chart.	
Controlled	Students work in pairs: Each pair is given 5 cards each.	7 min
Practice	Students discuss the group of pictures using the superlative	
	form.	
	Feedback to the class	
Listening	There are three exercises on the work sheet.	10 min
	Play the tape one time for each exercise.	
	Feedback for each exercise.	
Freer	Put pictures on the blackboard. Students are shopping.	5 min
Practice	Each pair has a certain amount of money.	
	They should compare the items and decide what they want	
	to buy.	
Role Play	Students are given time to prepare a short shopping role-	20 min
	play based on the previous activity.	
	Students act out their play in front of the class.	
Homework	Students complete the comparative and superlative work	
	sheets
